- 2. ATTITUDE OF GOOD WILL THAT MANIFESTS AN INTEREST IN A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP, GENEROSITY, FELLOW-FEELING
- 3. ABSTRACT FOR CONCRETE SIGN OF FELLOWSHIP, PROOF OF BROTHERLY UNITY, EVEN A GIFT, CONTRIBUTION
- 4. PARTICIPATION, SHARING




Biblical Idea:


